Location: Clark County Fairgrounds in Ridgefield, WA.

Directions: Ridgefield is located off of I-5 on the north side of Vancouver, WA. From the south head north on either I-5 or I-205, and just after the two freeways merge, take exit 9 and turn left to get to the Clark County Fairgrounds; past the horse entrance on the left you'll see a large multi-lane entrance – enter there at go to the yellow gate. From the north, take I-5 south to exit 9 and turn right for the fairgrounds; on the left you'll see a large multi-lane entrance – enter there at go to the yellow gate.. See map of grounds in this packet.

Arrival Info: Pens will be available after 3pm on July 3rd. When you arrive find a show host to show you the location of your pens. The livestock barn is on the south side of the Clark County fairgrounds. Animals may also be housed in the nearby small animal barn and/or sheep barn. Please leave your animals on the trailer until after they have been health-checked (full description on next page under pen sale also applies to show animals). After unloading please move your vehicle immediately so that others are able to unload near the barn entrances. Most of the pens are very strong newer metal pens with bars. If you are bringing very small kids, you may want to bring mesh to line your pens so small kids can't escape. Straw to bed the pens will be provided.

Camping: Tent and RV camping are available on the fairgrounds (no hook-ups). Camping fees are \$20 per family per weekend. There are many grassy areas on the fairgrounds where you are welcome to set up your tents and paved areas for parking rv's on the grounds. Minors staying on the fairgrounds must have a parent or designated adult chaperone staying with them. There are bathrooms near the barn with showers available. No fireworks allowed. Outdoor barbeques are welcomed if done safely outside the barn with adult supervision.

Dogs: Dogs on the fairgrounds must be on leash at all times and are not allowed in the barns unless by permission from the hosts. You must clean up any solid souvenirs left by your dog -- nobody wants to see, smell, or step in your dog's mess.

Hotels: There are several hotels one exit south of the fairgrounds in Salmon Creek, WA. The Inn at Salmon Creek is a lower priced option. La Quinta Inn and Suites, Holiday Inn Express Hotel & Suites, Days Inn & Suites Salmon Creek, and Shilo Inn Suites at Salmon Creek are closer & newer but a little pricier. The Days Inn and Shilo have restaurant, fast food and a grocery store in easy walking distance surrounding them.

PEN SALE Information:

Dates: Saturday, July 4th through noon on Sunday, July 5th

Pen sale animals will be housed in an area separate from the show animals with their pens clearly identified. Up to three junior animals or two yearling or senior animals may be housed in each pen. Senior bucks must be housed individually. Cost per sale pen is \$20, or six for \$100. Animals not for sale should not be kept in the sale pens.

Each animal will have a silent auction bidding sheet that will list the minimum bid and a buy-it-now price. Copies of the registration papers, show record, photographs and other information may also be included on the clipboard below the bid sheet for prospective buyers to review.

Start time: The pen sale will begin at 8am on Saturday and end at noon on Sunday unless the animal is purchased prior to then at the buy-it-now price. If at noon on Sunday, there are bidders still actively bidding on the animal, the seller may conduct a verbal bidding auction for those still bidding in order to obtain the final bid price and close the auction.

Registration: All animals in the pen sale must be ABGA registered unless clearly marked on the bid sheet that the animal is unregistered or is registered with another registry.

Entries: The show hosts reserve the right to close the pen sale to additional consignments prior to the weekend depending on pen availability.

Details: Health Inspection: Please leave animals on trailers until they have been inspected. Goats exhibiting lumps in anatomic proximity to lymph nodes, open sores, scabs, parasites, evidence of untreated footrot/scald or ringworm, respiratory disease, or evidence of other communicable disease should be left home, as they won't be admitted. All animals arriving at showgrounds will be screened by lay inspectors before unloading and may be denied entry on basis of evidence of the above concerns. The use of any performance enhancing drug and/or chemical, their substitutes or derivatives, is prohibited without written veterinary documentation.

The show hosts make no guarantees of the development, health, marketability, fertility or potential of the animals sold in the pen sale. The show hosts also cannot guarantee that sellers will accept any particular form of payment. Please discuss those details with the seller prior to bidding.

ABGA Show Information:

Dates: Saturday, July 4th: Two ABGA shows
Sunday, July 5th: One ABGA show

Show Information:

Start time: Saturday: the first ABGA show will begin at **8am**; the second show will follow the first.

Sunday: the ABGA show will start at **9 am**.

Location: All three ABGA open shows will occur in the southwest covered showing, located in between the livestock and small animal barns.

Judges: Show 1: Doug Glosser ; Show 2: Kent Davidson ; Show 3: Larry Epting

Registration: Animals entered into the ABGA shows must be registered with one of the recognized Boer goat registries (exception: ABGA does not recognize USBGA Native on Appearance or USBGA percentage buck registrations). Original registration certificates must be presented at check-in for any animal over 3mo old regardless of which registry they are registered with, per ABGA rules. Stamped received copies of applications for animals under 3mo old will be accepted. All three ABGA shows are official ABGA shows and ABGA rules shall govern. Please note: owners are responsible for ensuring their animals have legible tattoos; the judge will be the final determinant of legibility and reserves the right to dismiss any animal for lack of a legible tattoo per ABGA rules

Entries: The show hosts reserve the right to close any or all of the three ABGA shows to entries at any point prior to the show due to pen space or number of entries. If the show has not been closed by the show hosts, entries can be made until 7am for each days' ABGA shows. Substitutions will be allowed until 7am of each show day. Entries received after June 24th will not be in the show program.

Entry DATE Requirements: We are instituting a new entry practice used in other livestock shows. Please read this section carefully.

Opening date: **May 15, 2009: Oregon & Washington residents. June 1, 2009: all others.** Entries will be accepted with postmarks on or after the opening date. All entries must be delivered via mail or email. Entries sent without payment will not be considered received until payment is received. Payment may be made by check or by Paypal. No entries please before May 15th. Entries will be taken until the show is full due to pen space or number of entries. Show hosts may request that tack pens be shared. Pens are large enough to be shared by multiple goats (with the exception of senior bucks who can be housed singly).
